Cabinet clears...

It would also enable all urban local bodies in hilly States, North-Eastern States, and smaller ULBs with population below 1 lakh eligible for support under the Credit Reimbursement Scheme. In another major decision, the Cabinet also approved the establishment of the Startup India Fund of Funds 2.0 (Startup India FoF 2.0) with a total corpus of Rs. 10,000 crore for the purpose of mobilizing venture capital for the startup ecosystem of the country.

The Scheme has been designed to accelerate the next phase of India's startup journey by mobilising long-term domestic capital, strengthening the venture capital ecosystem, and supporting innovation-led entrepreneurship across the country, a Cabinet note said.

It added that since the launch of Startup India in 2016, the ecosystem has seen the number of startups increased from fewer than 500 to over 2 lakh now. As such, building on the success of the Startup India FoF 2.0, the government will address funding gaps and catalyse the domestic venture capital market for startups.

The Startup India FoF 2.0 has been designed to take Indian innovation to the next level by adopting a 'targeted and segmented funding approach' to support deep tech and tech-driven innovative manufacturing; providing a safety net to founders for new and innovative ideas; encouraging investment beyond major metros; and directing greater capital to priority areas which are important for self-reliance and boosting economic growth.

Likewise, Mansaaur Bhopal Green Field will come up in Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) scheme and its total length will be 258 km with an estimated cost of around Rs 855 crore.

The Gwalior-Bhind project till the border of Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh will be 116.4 km in length and its construction cost will be the highest i.e. Rs 3297.21 crore. It will come up under the HAM scheme.

Cost of 4 sanctioned projects Rs 13,890cr:

As far as the status of work of the MPRDC sanctioned projects is concerned, there are a total of four sanctioned projects having a total length of 254 km. Their total cost is Rs 13,890 crore. Bhopal Western By-Pass will have a length of 35.41 km and its construction cost will be Rs 4,848 crore. It will be completed by December 2028. Indore-Ujjain 4-lane greenfield will be constructed at the cost of Rs 3053 crore and its length will be 48 km. It will be completed by December 2027. All these projects will be constructed under the HAM scheme.

Tarique Rahman...

Rahman's BNP on Friday secured a sweeping victory with more than two-thirds majority in the landmark parliamentary elections held on Thursday. A massive student-led protest ousted Hasina's Awami League re-elected on August 5, 2024. Since then she has been living in exile in New Delhi as an in-

He said that the inaugurated projects would play a significant role in developing Burhanpur and making it self-reliant. The chief minister declared that a storage and processing unit will be established for banana-producing farmers in the district. The government is also launching a culture-based Regional Industry Conclave will be organised in Burhanpur. His other announcements included Shahpur Nagar Parishad's upgrade to a Municipal Council after due assessment. Horticulture as a subject will now be introduced in all colleges across the state.

The state government will ensure payment of pending dues to workers of the Burhanpur Co-operative Spinning Mill and will also facilitate the establishment of new industries in the district. Facilities for processing, storage and export of major crops such as banana and cotton will be further strengthened and expanded. Cotton and banana-based processing industries will also be established in Burhanpur, he added.

Chief Minister Mohan Yadav transferred over Rs 1,500 crore to women beneficiaries across the state through a single click during a grand Ladli Behna Conference at the Mandi premises in Pandhara constituency of Khandwa on Saturday. The amount marked the 33rd installment distributed under the Ladli Behna Yojana. He said that more than Rs 50,000 crore has been credited directly into the accounts of women so far.

Cong's symbolic ticket stunt challenges Modi

In a unique way of highlighting a burning issue, the Congress on Saturday bought an air ticket for Prime Minister Narendra Modi to fly from Guwahati in Assam and visit Manipur that has been witnessing ethnic violence, between the Meitei and Kuki communities since May 2023, which only recently got worse.

With Modi travelling to poll-bound Assam during the day, Congress's media and publicity department head Pawan Khera posted on "X" about the party's effort to bring the spotlight on Manipur.

"We understand that poll-bound states are always your top priority. But Manipur should not be abandoned. The state has been burning since

2023 - and it is burning again. You are already in Assam today. Manipur is just an hour away. Please go there as well," he wrote while sharing the images of the ticket which had been bought in Modi's name.

Khera insisted that "the presence of the Prime Minister can go a long way in reassuring our people in Manipur." He also urged the PM to use the ticket to "show

that the "PM CARES"?

Incidentally, the Opposition had made a major issue of Modi not visiting Manipur for over two years after the violence had started there. It was only in September 2025 that he visited the north eastern state where at least 260 people have been killed in ethnic clashes in two years.

Modi had during the visit stated that "in order to bring

life back on track in Manipur, the government of India is making all possible efforts" and announced that the government was supporting the construction of 7,000 new homes for the families displaced by the conflict. He had also urged both the communities to engage in dialogue, saying: "We should strengthen the bridge of brotherhood between the hills and the valley."

Andhra unveils Rs 3.32 lakh cr budget

The Andhra Pradesh government on Saturday presented a Budget of Rs 3,32,205 crore for the financial year 2026-27, positioning it as a roadmap aimed at balancing welfare commitments with long-term economic growth and infrastructure development.

Finance Minister Payayula Keshav tabled the Budget in the State Assembly, marking the third consecutive time he has presented the state's financial statement, including one Vote-on-Account and two full-fledged budgets. In the Budget presented, the revenue expenditure has been estimated at Rs 2,56,143 crore, while capital expenditure is projected at Rs 75,915 crore. The revenue deficit is pegged at Rs 22,002 crore, and the fiscal deficit at Rs 75,868 crore. According to news agency PTL, the budget seeks to balance welfare and development spending, with significant allocations across social and infrastructure sectors.

Earlier, during the enumeration phase, names of more than 58 lakh voters -- including deceased, duplicate and shifted voters -- were found ineligible and were excluded from the draft voters' list published in December last year.

BENGAL SIR HEARINGS END 4.98 lakh more voters identified for deletion

The hearing phase on claims and objections to the draft voters' list in West Bengal concluded on Saturday evening, with 4.98 lakh additional names identified as eligible for deletion from the final voters' list. These 4.98 lakh voters are those who abstained from attending the hearing sessions despite repeated notices being served to them and have therefore been found eligible for exclusion from the final voters' list.

The number of such voters who had abstained from attending the hearing sessions was in North 24 Parganas district, at around 138 lakh, followed by South 24 Parganas with about 46,000 and Kolkata (Dakhin) electoral district with around 22,000.

The lowest number of absentees was reported from Kalimpong district, at just 440.

Akhilesh slams Yogi gov't over Shankaracharya slur

Samajwadi Party president and former Uttar Pradesh chief minister Akhilesh Yadav on Saturday said the use of derogatory language against the Shankaracharya amounted to verbal violence and was a sin. In a post on X, Yadav said that attire may change but words reveal a person's true character. He said using grossly offensive slurs against a revered religious figure was sinful not only for the speaker but also for those who encouraged such remarks by applauding. He added that when Bharatiya Janata Party legislators step out of the House to face the public, people would hold them accountable on the streets.

Attacking the government, the former chief minister also disclosed that those who did not disclose accurate figures of deaths during the Maha Kumbh, allowed irregularities in compensation and failed to account for beneficiaries who did not receive relief had no moral right to question anyone's religious position. He also alleged that cases against the government were being withdrawn.

Minor disputes not grounds..: Raj HC refuses to dissolve 58-year-old marriage

The Rajasthan High Court has made important observations while refusing to dissolve the 58-year-old marriage of a couple aged over 75 years. The division

bench of Justice Sudesh Bansal and Justice Anil Kumar Upmanu, while dismissing the husband's appeal, stated that minor disagreements, quarrels, and ups and downs in marital life cannot be considered grounds for cruelty to justify divorce.

The court clarified that granting divorce at this stage could affect the dignity and reputation of not only the wife but the entire family. The court upheld the order of the Family Court, Bharatpur, and dismissed the husband's appeal.

Madras HC mandates microplastics warning on packaged foods

In a significant interim measure aimed at safeguarding public health, the Madras High Court has directed the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) to warn consumers about the possible presence of micro and nano plastics (MNFs) in packaged drinking water, salt and sugar sold in Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET) bottles and plastic packs.

comprising Justices N Sathish Kumar and D Bhārathra Chakravarthy ordered that labels on such packs must carry a warning in red, font size 10, stating: "This water [for salt/sugar] may contain micro/nano plastics".

The court has directed the Ministry and FSSAI to issue an appropriate notification within four weeks and instruct all companies selling drinking water, salt and sugar in PET bottles and plastic packaging to strictly comply with the new labelling requirement. The FSSAI has also been asked to file a status report by April 10.
